It Proclaims The Victory Of Life Over Death, Light Over Darkness, And Hope Over Despair, Assuring Believers Of New Life And Salvation In Christ. As The Culmination Of The Lenten Season, Easter Calls Us Into Joyful Worship, Renewal Of Faith, And A Deeper Reflection On The Power Of God Revealed Through The Resurrection.
