Good Morning And Praise God! Welcome To The Youth And Young Adults Service On Pentecost Sunday. Today, We Celebrate The Coming Of The Holy Spirit Upon The Disciples, As Recorded In Acts Of The Apostles 2, Marking The Birth Of The Church And Christ's Promise Fulfilled.
