Dear Brothers And Sisters In Christ, Welcome To This Blessed Celebration Of Trinity Sunday, A Sacred Day In The Anglican Tradition When The Church Reflects On The Mystery And Majesty Of The One True God Revealed In Three Persons: God The Father, God The Son, And God The Holy Spirit. Observed On The Sunday After Pentecost, Trinity Sunday Invites Us To Worship The Fullness Of God's Presence And Saving Work: The Father Who Created Us, The Son Who Redeemed Us, And The Holy Spirit Who Sanctifies And Sustains Us. Through Our Liturgy, Prayers, And Worship Today, We Join The Universal Church In Proclaiming This Holy Mystery Of Faith, Giving Thanks For The Unity, Love, And Communion Within The Triune God That Calls Us Into Deeper Fellowship With Him And With One Another.

11.THE ATHANASIUS CREED

Leader: We stand to affirm our faith in the words of Saint Athanasius Creed.

***All:* Whosoever will be saved: before all things it is necessary that he hold the Catholick Faith.**

Which Faith except every one do keep whole and undefiled: without doubt he shall perish everlastingly.

And the Catholick Faith is this: That we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity;

Neither confounding the Persons: nor dividing the Substance.

For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son: and another of the Holy Ghost.

But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, is all one: the Glory equal, the Majesty co-eternal.

Such as the Father is, such is the Son: and such is the Holy Ghost.

The Father uncreate, the Son uncreate: and the Holy Ghost uncreate.

The Father incomprehensible, the Son incomprehensible: and the Holy Ghost incomprehensible.

The Father eternal, the Son eternal: and the Holy Ghost eternal.

And yet they are not three eternals: but one eternal.

As also there are not three incomprehensibles, nor three
uncreated: but one uncreated, and one
incomprehensible.

So likewise the Father is Almighty, the Son Almighty: and the
Holy Ghost Almighty.

And yet they are not three Almightyes: but one Almighty.

So the Father is God, the Son is God: and the Holy Ghost is God.

And yet they are not three Gods: but one God.

So likewise the Father is Lord, the Son Lord: and the Holy Ghost
Lord.

And yet not three Lords: but one Lord.

For like as we are compelled by the Christian verity: to
acknowledge every Person by himself to be God and
Lord;

So are we forbidden by the Catholick Religion: to say there be
three Gods, or three Lords.

The Father is made of none: neither created, nor begotten.

The Son is of the Father alone: not made, nor created, but
begotten.

The Holy Ghost is of the Father and of the Son: neither made, nor
created, nor begotten, but proceeding.

So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons:
one Holy Ghost, not three Holy Ghosts.

And in this Trinity none is afore, or after other: none is greater, or
less than another;

But the whole three Persons are co-eternal together: and co-equal.

So that in all things, as is aforesaid: the Unity in Trinity, and the
Trinity in Unity is to be worshipped.

He therefore that will be saved: must thus think of the Trinity.

Furthermore it is necessary to everlasting salvation: that he also
believe rightly the Incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

For the right Faith is that we believe and confess: that our Lord
Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is God and Man;
God, of the Substance of the Father, begotten before the worlds:
and Man, of the Substance of his Mother, born in the
world;
Perfect God, and Perfect Man: of a reasonable soul and human
flesh subsisting;
Equal to the Father, as touching his Godhead: and inferior to the
Father, as touching his Manhood.
Who although he be God and Man: yet he is not two, but one
Christ;
One, not by conversion of the Godhead into flesh: but by taking of
the Manhood into God;
One altogether, not by confusion of Substance: but by unity of
Person.
For as the reasonable soul and flesh is one man: so God and Man
is one Christ.
Who suffered for our salvation: descended into hell, rose again the
third day from the dead.
He ascended into heaven, he sitteth on the right hand of the
Father, God Almighty: from whence he shall come to
judge the quick and the dead.
At whose coming all men shall rise again with their bodies: and
shall give account for their own works.
And they that have done good shall go into life everlasting: and
they that have done evil into everlasting fire.
This is the Catholick Faith: which except a man believe faithfully,
he cannot be saved.
Glory be to the Father, and to the Son: and to the Holy Ghost;
As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be: world without
end. Amen.

Minister: Almighty God, whose steadfast love is as great as the heavens are high above the earth, remove your sins from you as far as the east is from the west, strengthen your life in His kingdom and keep you upright to the last day; through Jesus Christ our merciful High Priest.

All: *Amen.* Thank You Father for forgiveness; we come to Your table as Your children, not presuming but assured, not trusting ourselves but Your Word; we hunger and thirst for righteousness, and ask for our hearts to be satisfied with the body and blood of Your Son, Jesus Christ the righteous. *Amen.*
