1. WELCOME REMARKS & OPENING PRAYER *(People Stand)*

Welcome To Our service today As We Gather To Worship On This Fifth Sunday After Trinity. In The Anglican Season After Trinity, Marked By The Green Liturgical Colour, We Are Reminded That God Calls Us To Grow In Faith, Bear Fruit In Our Christian Walk, And Live As Faithful Disciples Of Christ Through The Power Of The Holy Spirit. Today Is Also Our Family Thanksgiving Service, A Special Opportunity To Pause And Give Thanks To God For His Faithfulness Throughout The First Half Of This Year. As Individuals, Families, Our Church, Our Community, And Our Nation, We Come With Grateful Hearts, Remembering The Words Of Psalm 107:1: "Give Thanks To The Lord, For He Is Good; His Love Endures Forever." Whether You Have Come Rejoicing Or Seeking Strength, Know That You Are Welcome In God's Presence. May Our Hearts Be Filled With Gratitude, Our Faith Renewed, And Our Hope Strengthened As We Worship Together. Welcome, And Let Us Worship God Together!
